What is a dental implant?

A dental implant is a dental restoration that uniquely mimics a natural tooth's structure by replacing missing teeth with more than just a crown. The implant is generally composed of three parts:

- The implant post which is surgically placed and allowed to naturally fuse with the jawbone to function like a root
- The abutment which is usually placed on the end of the implant post
- The restoration which is the final tooth (crown) or set of teeth that will be attached to the abutment

These parts work together to create a permanent, stable restoration for dental patients who have lost some or all of their natural teeth.

What are the unique benefits of implants?

Dental implants have become incredibly popular mainly because of their many benefits. Compared to other restorative options like dentures and dental bridges, implants are permanent, and you will not need to damage existing teeth to place them. Because of their unique structure, dental implants can actually improve the health of your mouth by providing the necessary parts to keep your jawbone from deteriorating and causing other teeth to shift. This also benefits your entire facial structure as the bone loss that often follows tooth loss can add years to your face. With dental implants, your smile and your face can stay naturally youthful.

Implants are also as simple to clean as your natural teeth, making your regular dental hygiene habits easier to maintain, which will benefit the overall health of your smile. In addition, because they are permanently anchored in your jaw, implants are stable, so your mouth will not have to adjust to a new way of eating or speaking as it would with traditional dentures, and the implants will not shift in place or need to be removed. Essentially, dental implants are the restoration that will bring you the closest to all the benefits of having your natural teeth back. In time, you may even forget you ever lost your teeth.
